



COMIC BOOK DRAWERBOXES™ THE EASY ACCESS STORAGE SOLUTION™ ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Congratulations, you have purchased the most practical storage container designed for comic books. Unfortunately, like most products today, some assembly is required. The good news is that batteries are not required. At least until we invent a digital box...! In the meantime, we hope that you will find these instructions helpful.

First, let's check to make sure you have all the components. The "Comic Book DrawerBox" has four parts: A Shell, a Drawer (it's the odd shaped piece) and 2 sleeves (the smaller of the 4 pieces). If you don't have all three components, call your friendly neighborhood supplier now!

They are all there? Good. Let's get started.

Step 1: Locate the Shell piece and unfold it into a square. Notice that the handle slot is closer to one side. That will be the top of the unit and the seam will be on the bottom.

Step 2: Take the Sleeves and fold them along the four creases. Insert the Sleeves into the shell, one on each side, so that the ends are on the top and bottom of the box, and the ends meet each other.

Step 3: Locate the end of the Shell with the shorter flats. Generally, this is found opposite the end with the longer flaps. Find it? Good! Now fold the shorter top and bottom flaps in along both perforations. Then fold the side flaps in. Note that there is a tab on the end of the top and bottom flaps that will insert into the narrow portion of the side flaps. These flaps will fold over the Sleeve.

Step 4: On the opposite end, fold the top and bottom flaps in first, then the side flap without the tabs. Finally, fold the flap with the tabs. The tabs will tuck into the slots provided. Make sure the tabs slide into the slot under the sleeve, so they are not exposed on the inside.

Step 5: Time for a break!

Step 6: Back? Good. Now we will assemble the drawer piece. First swing the four corners of the drawer piece along the perforations until they come loose. No, they didn't break. That was intentional. These will become your dividers.

Step 7: Fold the drawer piece along the four creases so that the sides of the box are formed. The four flaps on either end of the sides should then be folded in.

Step 8: Fold the end piece on either end up and then over the side flaps. Tuck the tabs into the slots on the bottom of the drawer piece on both sides.

Step 9: Finally! (Hey, don't blame us if this is taking a long time, YOU were the one that took the break) Insert the drawer piece into the shell assembly.

The box can be filled with comics. Remember, they can be stacked up to 6' (6 boxes) high. If you go that high we do suggest stacking several columns side by side so that the stack is more stable and preferably putting at least one side against a wall.
